4 ASCA Arena Trials Course A & B May 17th & 18th

May 17th: First trial starts at 7:30 AM. Course A with 40 runs total; 20 sheep and 10 for each
cattle and ducks.

Second trial (Course B) will start after 12 PM with 40 runs total; 20 sheep and 10 for each cattle
and ducks.

May 18th: Third trial starts at 7:30 AM. Course B with 40 runs total; 20 sheep and 10 for each
cattle and ducks.

Fourth trial will start after 12 PM. Course A with 40 runs total; 20 sheep and 10 for each cattle
and ducks. Trials to be judged by: Shannon Oxford and Maxine Schvanveldt

Each trial will have placements and High Trial ribbons. Each individual run for each stock costs
\$30. Entry opens April 9th. Day of entries cost \$35 per run. Send entries to: Dicky Renn PO Box

******ATTENTION EXHIBITORS******

These shows will be judged and run by the Show Rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the chairman will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. Entry fees will only be refunded if the refund request is received before the pre-entry closing date, no entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons or riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or public emergency. The show-giving club, the Show Chairman, their agents, officers, and/or committee shall assume no responsibility for injury to children. Judges may be substituted. All dogs must be leashed or crated at all times, except when competing. No electrical and /or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the show grounds. Please clean up after your dogs. For the safety of your dogs and others, all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies, distemper/parvo.

HERDING SPECIFICATIONS The herding trials are open to all breeds on first come, first serve basis. The trials will consist of a maximum of 40 runs per judge, or until stock limitations are reached. Handler is responsible for his dog and must keep the dog under his control at all times. Dog will be brought to and from the ring on leash. Handler will be responsible for any injury caused by their actions or that of their dog. Owner of any dog causing any livestock losses will be charged \$500.00 per cow, \$125.00 per sheep or \$15.00 per duck. Runs will be determined randomly prior to trial. Bitches in season will run last and must be crated away from the arenas at other times. Ducks 5 head--- cattle 3 head --- sheep 3 head unless otherwise announced at handlers meeting.

NOTE: Non ASCA registered dogs competing in ASCA trials will need a tracking # issued by ASCA to earn ASCA titles. Entries without a tracking # will not count towards titles/awards. Go to: www.asca.org for entry forms, rules, & tracking #'s.

Directions

To use Map Quest, address is: 3020 Buckeystown Pike, Buckeystown, MD, 21717

From South take 270 to the 85 South/Buckeystown exit. Farm is about 5-6 miles from the exit.

The farm is the second farm lane on the right past Buckeystown.

From East and West take 70 to the 270/Washington D.C. exit to the 85 South/Buckeystown exit.

Then follow the South directions above.

From North follow 15 to 270 and then the 85 S/Buckeystown exit and follow the South directions above.
